

Chipotle Cassorole

TOPPINGS

Shredded lettuce I Chipotle sauce I Sour cream

FIRST LAYER

5 c. diced chicken 2 Tbsp. lemon juice 1 tsp. taco seasoning 1 tsp. oregano 1 tsp. garlic salt 1/2 tsp. chili powder

Mix chicken and all ingredients together, tossing until chicken is coverd. Marinate for 4 hours. Place in 9 x 13 pan; bake for 20 minutes, stiring once.

SECOND LAYER

2 1/2 c. water 1 tsp. garlic powder 1/2 tsp. oregano 1 tsp. pink salt

1 1/2 Tbsp. coconut oil 1/2 tsp. parsley flakes

1 1/2 c. rice

THIRD LAYER

2 c. black beans, drained 1 tsp. chili powder 1/2 tsp. pink salt

FORTH LAYER

2 c. whole kernel corn 2 c. shredded cheddar cheese Bring first 6 ingriedents to a boil. Add rice; let set until rice is tender. Drain; pour on top of baked chicken.

Mix all ingriedients together; pour over rice

Drain corn and put on top of beans.

Last add cheese.

Bake, covered, at 350 for 15-20 minutes

Serve with toppings

Trashcan Dinner

INGREDIENTS

3 1/2 dz Corn

10 lbs Potatoes

2-3 Small Cabbage Heads Peppers: green, yellow, or hot

6 Onions

3lbs Carrots

20-30 lb Smoked, precooked sausage



STEP 1

Take outer layer of husks off corn, leaving some husks on, cutt off tips, scrub potatoes and carrots(do not peel) Cut peppers, onions, cabbage, in quarters or smaller.

STEP 2

In bottom of 30 gallon steel trashcan, put 5 empty tin cans. Layer vegtables & meat on top of the grate, putting a carrot on the very top.

STEP 3

Put trashcan over a turkey burner, and cook for 1 1/2 hours. when carrot is soft, it is ready to eat. Dump entire trashcan onto a table. leave food on tablecloth and everyone picks out what they want to eat.
