

Pizza Roll

TOPPINGS

1 c. Pizza Sauce 2c. Shredded Mozzarella

Mushrooms

Banana Peppers

Onions

INGREDIENTS

1lb. Hamburger

1lb. Sausage

1 &1/2 tsp. Salt 1/4 tsp. Pepper

STEP 1

Mix together until well blended. Press hamburger mixture out on one piece of plastic wrap, approximately 10x14 in size.

STEP 2

Top with pizza sauce and 1 cup cheese. Add rest of toppings and roll up like a log. Peel plastic wrap off as you roll.

STEP 3

Bake at 350 for 35 minutes or until done. Top with rest of cheese when done baking.



Blender Freezer Waffels

INGREDIENTS

1 & 1/2 Pkgs Cream Cheese 3 Large Eggs

3/4 c. Egg Whites

1 Tbsp. Baking Powder

3 Tbsp. Coconut Oil

1/4 c. & 2 Tbsp. Whey

Protein Powder

1/4 c. & 2 Tbsp. THM

or your own baking blend

2 tsp. Vanilla Extract

2/3 c. Unsweetened Cashew

or Almond Milk or Water

1 & 1/2 tsp. Gluccie or

Xanthum Gum



Turn on your waffle iron and spray it well with coconut oil cooking spray.

STEP 2

While the iron is heating, put all the ingredients in a blender and blend for about 30 seconds. Let the mixture rest for 10 seconds, the blend again for another minute. Leave the batter to rest for about 10 minutes to thicken up.

STEP 3

Put a generous 1/4 cup of batter in each waffle square and cook according to your waffle irons instructions. You should get between 13 and 16 waffles, depending on the size of your iron. Freeze the waffles, 2 to 3 in baggie, and toast to heat.
